

EXCLUSIVE: Waukesha County Court Commissioner Molly Jasmer Again Sets Absurdly Low Bail For Repeat Criminal

A Franklin man free on bail pending a plea and sentencing hearing in Milwaukee County for leading authorities on a high speed chase was arrested again in Waukesha County after crashing an allegedly stolen car. Despite the fact that the defendant, Adam Demeyers, 20, of Franklin is free on bail on the pending Milwaukee County case, Waukesha County Court Commissioner Molly Jasmer Monday set bail at only \$1000 cash on the new charges against Demeyers. It is not the first time Jasmer has set ridiculously low bail for an individual already faces multiple charges in separate cases.

Jasmer was the commissioner who released on minimal bail the repeat drunk driver who caused a fatal accident on I-94 near Delafield that killed a "good Samaritan" who was assisting another motorist.

In the most recent case, Demeyers and three other people were arrested Sunday morning in Muskego after crashing a car reported stolen from Indiana. Demeyers is charged with operating a vehicle without owner's consent and multiple other drug, weapon and obstruction charges. He was scheduled to plead guilty last Monday in Milwaukee County on separate charges stemming from a high speed chase last year. That hearing was postponed until next month. The most recent incident occurred only six days after the postponed Milwaukee hearing. Demeyers was charged with bail jumping in Waukesha County in connection with violating his bail from that case. Despite this, Jasmer, set bail at only \$1000 in the new case. If Demeyers posts it, he will be released to potentially violate more laws.
