EXCLSUIVE: Media Is Falsely Reporting Milwaukee Police Arrests For Violating Evers' Order

Milwaukee Police sources tell me several media outlets are inaccurately reporting that the Police Department has arrested 107 people for violating Gov. Tony Evers' "Safer At Home" order.

Police sources say the department is only using the "Safer At Home" citations as an add-on to individuals being arrested for other crimes. No one, according to these sources, is being cited without an investigation into separate behavior. For example, someone caught burglarizing a home may be given an additional citation for violating Evers' order. Individuals are not being cited for merely violating the Evers' order with no underlying separate offense.
