

EXCLUSIVELY: Federal Investigation Into Sexual Harassment In Wisconsin National Guard Is Over And Has Been Given To Governor Evers

A federal investigation into sexual harassment in the Wisconsin Army and Air National Guards has been completed and a lengthy report has been given to Governor Tony Evers who hasn't told anybody he has received it.

State Senator Scott Fitzgerald, the Senate Republican Leader who asked Evers to look into numerous complaints of harassment within both the Air and Army National Guard units, was not aware the report has been completed or that Evers has it. A Madison based Guard member has alleged that top Guard officials are retaliating against members who have complained.

I am attempting to obtain communications between Evers' staff and Major General Daniel Dunbar, the adjutant general of the Guard and head of the state Department of Military Affairs. Dunbar has held the position for years and was on the job long before Evers was elected Governor. Dunbar reports to the governor.
