

State Senate Democratic Leader Hires As Aide Woman Who Made Racist And Sexist Tweets

A woman who was dumped from her position with the Wisconsin College Democrats after I reported on her racist and sexist social media posts has been hired as an aide to Democrat State Senate Leader Jennifer Schilling of La Crosse.

Semrad also bragged on social media about going around the UW-La Crosse campus and tearing down fliers posted by Christian groups that did pregnancy counseling. Semrad resigned from her leadership post and apologized after my report. Now, she's a state legislative aide.
