I have learned Governor Walker intends to get rid of the Wisconsin Housing and Economic Development Agency (WHEDA) as part of a reform of the state's various agencies. WHEDA has been the agency that has overseen commercial and individual real estate and business lending. Sources tell me Walker may also merge the Department of Workforce Development and the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation into a single agency with the former WHEDA, but final decisions haven't been made.
