

EXCLUSIVE: Accused Froedtert Murderer Was Released From Jail Without Charges One Night Before Parking Garage Attack

I have learned that Kenneth B. Freeman II, the man accused of brutally murdering Nurse Carlie Beaudin in the Froedtert Hospital parking complex last week, was released from the Milwaukee County Jail one night earlier after being arrested for threatening Milwaukee Police.

Freeman has no criminal record in Wisconsin. He was, however, taken into custody last week after an incident with Milwaukee Police officers who were responding to another call. Freeman allegedly screamed at the officers and was holding a hammer. He was released from the jail without charges after a review by an assistant Milwaukee County District Attorney.

One day later, he allegedly murdered Carlie Beaudin.
