

## **Two Republican House Members From Wisconsin Vote To Place Statue Of Roe V. Wade Supreme Court Justice In Capitol**

**Two Wisconsin Republican members of the US House voted Wednesday to remove a statue of the Supreme Court Justice who wrote the infamous Dred Scott opinion with a statue of a justice who voted for an equally depraved court ruling.**

**The House voted to remove a bust of Roger Taney, the chief justice who wrote the infamous 1853 opinion essentially allowing slavery and denying full rights to Blacks. But Taney's bust would be replaced with one of Thurgood Marshall, one of the justices who voted for the equally immoral 1973 Roe vs. Wade opinion that essentially legalized abortion.**

**The two Wisconsinites are Mike Gallagher of Green Bay and Bryan Steil of Janesville. Steil represents the old Paul Ryan district in the southeast corner of the state. Gallagher's vote is not surprising given that he is a moderate who constantly kisses up to the Washington establishment. But Steil's vote is an eye-opener and seems to indicate his stated opposition to abortion is not heartfelt.**

**It is my opinion the Dred Scott and Roe rulings are the two worst in American legal history because both denied human beings all of their**

**basic Constitutional and natural rights. To see two Wisconsin Republicans memorialize a Roe supporter is sickening.**

**Two other Wisconsin Republicans, Glenn Grothman and Tom Tiffany, voted against the measure, which passed easily. Jim Sensenbrenner, who has been mourning the death of his wife, was not present and didn't vote.**

**Perhaps Steil and Gallagher will next vote to put up a statue of Margaret Sanger, the white supremacist who founded Planned Parenthood.**
