

EXCLUSIVE: Ozaukee-Washington Health Board Member Who Mocked Mask Opponents For Low IQ Asked To Resign

The County Executive of Washington County and the County Board Chair of Ozaukee County are calling for the resignation of the joint county health board member who, at a recent meeting, said opponents of mask wearing have low IQs.

The comment was reported exclusively by me and was made by Cathy Cero-Jaeger at the most recent meeting of the Health Board which oversees the health department run jointly by the two counties.

Cero-Jaeger is one of Ozaukee County's representatives on the board.

Washington County Executive Josh Schoemann tells me Cero-Jaeger's comments do not reflect his county's views and that other Washington County officials agreed to support his demand for Cero-Jaeger's resignation. Schoemann says the Ozaukee County leader, Board Chair Schlenvogt, agreed with the need for Cero-Jaeger to step down.
