

Wauwatosa City Council Member Defends Vandalism Of City Businesses

Wauwatosa Alderperson Heather Kuhl, the leader of a leftist wing on the council, has made a social media post defending the vandalism and looting of several Wauwatosa businesses during last week's protests over the Alvin Cole shooting.

Writing about the extensive damage to businesses on North Avenue in Wauwatosa and on Burleigh Street in Milwaukee, Kuhl posted: "We also love Black people and understand that windows are easier to repair than bodies."

Many of Kuhl's posts on Twitter are vulgar. She also defended protestors that were carrying guns over the last several days, saying Wisconsin is a concealed carry state.
