

Milwaukee County Court Commissioner Lets Attempted Murderer Out On Low Bail: You Guess What Happened Next

One of the men accused of attempting to murder his child's mother this month in Wauwatosa was free on low bail after allegedly attempting to kill the same woman last year.

Milwaukee County Court Commissioner Rosa Barillas last year set cash bail of \$7500 for Cory D. Smith after he was charged with attempted homicide and other charges for the attempted killing of the woman who is the mother of his child. Barillas also ordered that Smith wear an electronic monitoring device.

His case, like many others, has dragged out for a year. Numerous cases have been delayed because of Covid. The 2019 case is still pending and Smith's bail is still in effect. He was released in November of last year.

Earlier this month, Smith and his brother, Bryan G. Smith, also of Milwaukee, were charged with attempting to kill the same woman. She was shot seven times and was found near the intersection of 94th and Congress. The victim has survived. The weapon that managed to not kill her was a 9-milliment handgun.

Both Smiths are back in custody. Cory Smith is facing attempted homicide charges (again) and multiple counts of bail jumping.
