

Hypocrisy Alert: New Berlin West Athletic Director Breaks Own Social Distancing Rules, Then Throws Out Spectator For Not Wearing Mask

The athletic director at New Berlin West High School is admitting to me that he threw a fan out of a girls basketball game for not wearing a mask, even though he himself also broke his school's own social distancing guidelines.

Jordan Napoli is admitting that he spoke close up with an official from Pewaukee High School about procedures for the end of the game and didn't abide by the six foot social distancing rule he and New Berlin schools established. Napoli is seen on the YouTube video of the game sitting right next to the Pewaukee official. Moments later, a man who showed up at the game to pick up his daughter was ordered to leave the building because he wasn't wearing a mask. The parent was at the end of the gymnasium and not close to anybody else.

Napoli admits to me that he should have stayed farther away from the other spectators at the game but defends his ejection of the parent, stating the mask rule has no exceptions.
