EXCLUSIVE: Brookfield Central Principal Apologizes For Lurid Sex Survey Given To Health Students By Mark Belling, WISN-AM

A health teacher at Brookfield Central High School recently gave students a survey seeking their responses to a series of lurid sexual questions, including inquiries about the number of times students had multiple sex partners and whether they performed specific sexual acts. The survey was sent to the students online meaning the responses and the survey itself may still be on computers belonging to kids or others.

A parent addressed the issue at a recent meeting of the Elmbrook School Board but board members sat mute and didn't respond. Since then, however, the survey has been shared widely among Brookfield parents, many of whom have complained to school officials. The school principal, Brett Gruetzmacher, has sent an email to parents acknowledging the survey was inappropriate and apologized for it. He stated the school will take steps to make sure nothing like this happens again.
