EXCLUSIVE: Kenosha County DA In Charge Of Disgraceful Rittenhouse Prosecution Is Named Wisconsin "Prosecutor Of The Year"

While the assistants he assigned to handle the Kyle Rittenhouse murder trial were botching the case and making national fools of themselves, the Kenosha County District Attorney was at a conference receiving an award for Wisconsin "Prosecutor of the Year."

The award was handed out by the Wisconsin District Attorney's Association last week. Michael Graveley showed up to accept the award at the exact same time his assistant DA, Thomas Binger, was handling the prosecution of Rittenhouse who is accused of murder in connection with three shootings he was involved in during the Kenosha riots. Binger, Graveley's assistant, has so badly butchered the case that he has become a national laughingstock. Binger has repeatedly been bawled out in court by the trial judge for inappropriate conduct and Binger's own witnesses appeared to make Rittenhouse's case for self defense.

The decision to charge Rittenhouse was made by Graveley, even if he bugged out of actually handling the prosecution himself. One of the members of the Wisconsin District Attorney's Association is Fond du Lac County DA Eric Toney, a GOP candidate for attorney general. Toney tells me he had nothing to do with the selection of Graveley and that it was "tone deaf" for the Kenosha DA to show up in person to collect the award at the same time the trial was going on back in Kenosha. Toney refused to comment on the case itself.
