

Mark Is Named To Talkers Magazine "Heavy Hundred" List Of Nation's Most Important Talk Show Hosts (AGAIN)

Talkers Magazine Annually Names America's 100 most important talk show hosts. WISN-AM's Mark Belling made the list again, as he has for virtually every year the list has been in existence (dating back to the 1990s). Mark is ranked 51st and the only talk show hosts ranked higher host either national shows or are in top ten markets. The only exception is legendary Bill Cunningham of WLW in Cincinnati who finished one notch higher than Mark at #50. Mark has said he considers Cunningham and himself to be the most successful local talk show hosts in America.

The only other Wisconsin talk radio host to crack the "Heavy Hundred" was WTMJ-AM's Jeff Wagner who snuck in just above the cut at #93.

One other note: In an indication of just how awful talk radio is in Chicago, America's third largest market, only one Chicago host made the list and he came in at #89, barely beating out Jeff Wagner.
