

## **EXCLUSIVE: Sheboygan County Clerk Tells Local Clerks Not To Accept For Voting State IDs Given To Non-Citizens**

While the head of the Wisconsin Election Commission and many local clerks continue to do nothing to stop non-citizens from voting in Wisconsin with a new type of drivers license, the Sheboygan County Clerk is proactively taking matters into his own hands.

Clerk Jon Dolson tells me he has sent letters to all 28 local municipal clerks in Sheboygan County not to accept drivers licenses or state issued ID cards that list the holder as "NON-DOMICILED." DMV recently started issuing these cards to non-US citizens who are in the country both legally and illegally. The cards have caused havoc in the ongoing election as many local clerks don't know if they are acceptable ID for voting. Wisconsin Election Commission Executive Director Meagan Wolfe is refusing to give clerks guidance on whether to accept the "non-domiciled" IDs.

The Republican Vice Chair of the Commission, Don Millis, says he will try to get the full commission to address the issue next Friday but that's the end of the early voting period in Wisconsin.

It is illegal for a non-citizen to vote in this state but many of them are registered to vote and it's hard to catch them as we lack a database of non-citizens living in Wisconsin (either legally or illegally). You need to show photo ID to register and vote in Wisconsin and a drivers license or state ID card is normally sufficient. But the new "non-domiciled" IDs seem to be proof the person cannot vote legally. To my knowledge, Sheboygan County's Dolson is the only county clerk to tell local communities not to accept these IDs. Wolfe and the WEC, already beset with a train wreck in early voting because of insufficient server space causing delays to label ballots, has refused to say anything about the looming non-domiciled ID scandal. Wolfe has refused to respond to my questions.

The chair of the Wisconsin Republican Party, Brian Schimming, has not addressed the issue either.
